


2024 Marching Band Class Information

- All students, whether woodwind, brass, percussion or colorguard, should be registered for "Marching Band"
- 8th hour class (after school....however, we only rehearse certain days a week)
- PE Credit after 4 semesters of Marching Band
- Tuesday After School Sectional
 2:30pm-5:00pm
- Monday and Wed or Thurs Night Rehearsals
 5:30pm-9:15pm
- A few Saturday rehearsals in August/September



All instrumentalists are required to also be in an ensemble during the day (Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band or Jazz Band)

Financial Commitment

2024 Fees are \$975 per Student

- Total budget for Fall is almost 100k for Marching Band
 - Fees cover: Music, Drill, Props, Transportation, Uniforms, Staff, Equipment, etc.
- Costs have risen quite a bit over the last couple of years
- \$900 paid to BPO/\$75 is paid to Gilbert Schools as the class fee

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I rent an instrument for the summer?

There is no charge for summer rental. Rental fees will be due in the beginning of the year

Why do students switch instruments?

We will likely need to switch a few instruments around to create a balanced ensemble. We try to respect students wishes, while also creating a successful balance for the group.

Does my student need private lessons?

While it is not mandatory to get private lessons, it is strongly encouraged. There is a private lesson staff here on campus and your students can take lessons when school starts on campus. Please don't hesitate to ask for a form to get your students a private teacher.

What if I miss band camp?

Marching band is a very team-oriented activity in which attendance is a crucial aspect. Any time a student is missing, band camp or not, it negatively effects the ensemble. Please check the band calendar for our schedule to avoid these conflicts. Sick students should try and attend without jeopardizing further illness. If students miss rehearsal, and there is an alternate available, the alternate will take the spot. If the staff feels the student will be too far behind, they will not be performing until caught up.

How can I help?

There are numerous activities that the boosters help support the band with. From organizing uniforms, to running fundraisers, to building racks and helping with water at competitions. We need lots of help! Please be available and willing to volunteer. When emails are sent out, be proactive. In the end, it all helps your students have a better experience in the Campo Verde Bands.
